Here are some places to find books online until Libraries open up again:



Libby App: This app is how individuals can access OverDrive eBooks from the Dallas Public Library. Once you download the App, you can link it to your Dallas Public Library account. When I signed myself up, I needed my Dallas Public Library account number and a PIN. Your PIN should be the last 4 digits of your account number. Audiobooks are also available to borrow, and they have a wonderful children's selection.



Kindle Unlimited: Kindle Unlimited has a selection of eBooks for use on an actual Kindle device or the Kindle app. The selection is OK, especially for kids 9-12. It costs \$9.95 a month (even if you have Prime), but there are lots of trial offers for a free month or two.



eBay: In addition I utilize eBay for books. ThriftBooks and Better World Books both sell used books on eBay for very low prices, and often have free shipping and deals for purchasing multiple amounts. You can often find new books as well, or books that have only been read one time. eBay is also a good place to shop for old series, such as purchasing the entire Beverly Cleary collection and the like.



Half Price Books: Of course this is somewhere I will go. I love browsing the Clearance section. It is easy to find something at Half Price Books!
