First Trimester	August	Intro to Art room expectations; Sketchbooks; Elements of Art and Principles of Design (used all trimester)	Art room etiquette i.e. proper handling of art materials and clean-up, respecting others' artwork, as well as one's own; Drawing practice using various forms of media, brainstorming/planning of ideas, and reflective writing; Identify in artworks that color, texture, form, line, space, and value are basic art elements and that the principles such as emphasis, pattern, rhythm, balance, proportion, and unity serve as organizers.
