SPECIALS ART YEAR AT A GLANCE

FIRST GRADE

- Color, texture, form, line, and emphasis
- Texture crayon rubbings with watercolor wash
- Calacas (skeletons)

SECOND GRADE

- Express ideas and feelings using color, form, and line
